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
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NEW YEAR 2009

INAUGURATION OF TWO MAJOR PROJECTS ...

It gives us immense pleasure in updating about the much awaited projects. The first of these was the procurement of a mini bus exclusively for Vasantham. The urgency for this van was felt bearing in mind the growing number of children and the inadequacy of the available conveyance. Currently, very few children use auto and car to commute between school and home. This mini bus helps a greater number of children travel comfortably. As the need became more crucial, we have been trying to raise funds for this project. With the donations and loan from bank, we managed to get this mini bus. Mr. Suresh Kamath, CMD, Laser Soft Infosystems & member of Vasantham's board of management, inaugurated the mini bus.

The second project undertaken during this 20th year of Vasantham's journey was to renovate the hall on 2nd floor. This was focused on meeting the needs for group therapies, classrooms, meetings and recreational activities. This project was supported by many generous and service minded people. Smt. Yashumathi Doshi (President-Stri Mandal) & W/o. Harshad Doshi (Doshi Housing) inaugurated the hall.
