SUMMER VACATION

New children were admitted during the last week of May and early June 2011. A total of 19 new children have been admitted to this new academic year at Vasantham. Ten of our children have left us for reasons such as employment, inclusive education in mainstream school and shift of residence.

One of the volunteers entertained the kids with mimicry. Apart from staff from Vasantham, volunteers from Hella Engineering, Dream India and Punnagai Charitable Trust joined us. Volunteers from Hella Engineering also donated gifts, teaching materials and fan for Vasantham children. PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING

The first quarterly programme plan meeting was held on the 11th of June 2011. All the students were assessed for the current performance during the last week of May and first week of June 2011. Current status of every student, depending on their performance in various specific goals, and the goals for next 3 months were available for the parents and guardians. General rules and regulations and other updates regarding the progress of the institution and upcoming events and goals were discussed with the parents. Parents also discussed regarding the activities their children were engaged in during the holidays and the challenges faced by them during this time.

NEW INITIATIVE

Considering the challenges faced in inclusive education, i.e. integrating children with special needs in regular school, a new initiative has budded. Since June 2011, at Vasantham separate classes have begun for our children with special needs who are capable of following the mainstream syllabus. Few children who have been attending regular school and few more from Vasantham are attending these classes. Classes have been grouped based on the knowledge and performance of the children, as in 1 standard, 5th standard and so on. Few parents and well-wishers with regular school teaching background and a person from DPI are providing suggestions and advise with respect to curriculum and resources. These children will be prepared to appear for the National Open School exam from 8th standard onwards. Till then, regular monthly, quarterly and annual evaluations will be carried out by the school itself.

RENEWAL OF RECOGNITION

The process of renewal of recognition from the office of the state commissioner for the differently-abled is complete. This renewal is valid till the month of May, 2013.
